Multifuntion Port Change to ENFit

Enfit compatible Multifunction Port Will be in stock on March 12th.

The new ENFit Enteral Syringe easily connects to the Kangaroo Multi-functional Port via ENFit connection, to reduce the risk of enteral tube feeding misconnections and improves patient safety.

Steps:

- Verify feeding tube or access device/extension set is ENFit compatible.
- Proceed to thread the ENFit syringe to the Multifunction Port.
 - ⇒ When attaching the ENFit syringe to the ENFit Transition connector be sure the syringe tip is free of medication or debris.
- The ENFIT syringe and connector are now ready to be used on the Kangaroo Multi-functional Port or PEG tubing.



Central Logistics carries Kangaroo Multi-functional Port with Single Lumen Adapter which make it possible to connect the Kangaroo Multi-functional Port to a PEG Tube.

Steps:

- Call Central Logistic and request a Kangaroo Multifunctional Port with Single Lumen Adapter
- Open the package containing both the Kangaroo Multifunctional Port and the package containing the Single Lumen adapter
- Apply the Single Lumen Port adapter to the bottom (the double sided prong) of the Kangaroo Multi-functional Port
- The tubing is now ready to connect to the non ENFit compatible PEG Tube.
- Soon you will begin seeing ENFit compatible PEG Tubes inserted

All ENFit Syringes, ENFit Transitional Connectors, and Kangaroo Multi-functional Ports with Single Lumen Adapter are available for patient use, and located on the unit or Central Logistics.
