PROCESS CHANGE/NEW KNOWLEDGE

TOPIC 1: Modified Early Warning Signs (MEWS) Alert

Effective December 17, 2018 the MEWS Alert in KD*Hub (Cerner) will be turned off.

Justification:

- Alert is over-firing
- Multiple alerts continue after the nurse is aware of changes in patient condition and interventions have been documented.
- Alert needs additional evaluation and changes such as
- Alignment with SOV parameters including urine output, capillary refill, pain, base excess, and lactic acid
- Consider decrease sensitivity and suppressing certain patient populations

Recommendations:

- <u>Continue to use 10 Signs of Vitality (SOV)</u> for early recognition of patient deterioration
- An interdisciplinary team will evaluate changes to improve effectiveness of the MEWS Alert
