TOPIC 3: No One Dies Alone (NODA)

NO One Dies Alone (NODA) is new program of Kaweah Delta that is supported by employees and volunteers to ensure that no patient dies alone.

Criteria:

- Patients on comfort care and the family is not involved or not present
- DNR status expected to die within 48-72 hours and the family is not involved or not present

What staff need to know about the Activation of NODA:

- Use the Vigil Flow chart to activate NODA
 - 1. Patient has no family visiting
 - 2. Attending RN discusses NODA with the Charge RN (CN)
 - 3. Determine if NODA is appropriate
 - 4. CN request NODA via House Supervisor
 - 5. House Supervisor contacts NODA Vigil Coordinator and activates team
